Grammar note

- if a word has a reduplication (²/₂) that word gets an "other" meaning:

babar --> babar² - other elephant(s)

- Only a few word has plurality:

eg.: pronouns: ego --> ego² - we

some nouns: kūklops --> tenxinhan - eyes

- there is no grammar cases
- isolating language with a small agglutative suffixes (like anti-, prä-, -txän, -stän)
- letters with two dots over them don't change the pronunciation of these letters. The reason they have that they show that they are suffixes (some of them can be used as a separated word).
- tenses are not always used if the sentence is understood without them. There are 3 tenses;
